## **School News**

#### Meal prices

#### Free school Meals—Important Information

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in state funded schools in England are eligible for a school dinner, under a government scheme, called a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) this meal is provided free. However, some children will also be eligible to receive **extra funding** under the current Free School Meals scheme which is based on the benefits parents may receive —



To be eligible for Free School Meals you need to be in receipt of one or more of the following benefits: -

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support (IS)
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income that does not exceed £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

#### How to apply for FSM

Parents/Carers can apply for Free School Meals through <u>Devon Citizens Portal</u> to check eligibility which provides an instant result.

It is very important that we still identify pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. This is because each child registered under the Free School Meal scheme attracts valuable funding for our school.

Please come and speak to Mrs Lake if you think your child may be eligible for Free School Meals especially if they are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.
