Message from the Headteacher

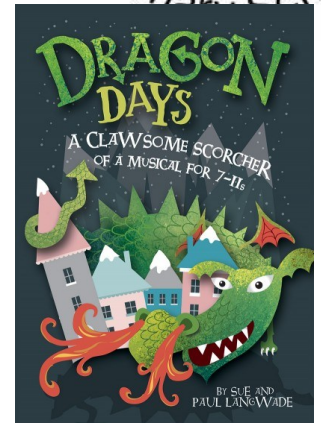
Good Afternoon Parents and Carers,
