A reminder that the deadline for the return of the questionnaire that was recently sent home to you is Monday 1st July.


We wish the organisers of the Bratton Fleming Village Festival all the very best for the forthcoming festival 'The Greatest Show' this Saturday at the Sports Club.


Class Caen
