### A Message from Mrs Denham

We would like to remind parents of any child in Reception to Year 6, that if they are in receipt of any of the following benefits/allowances they are entitled to Pupil Premium/Free School Meals. It is very important that we identify these pupils, as the scheme attracts valuable funding for our school. We will receive £1,320 for each child who is entitled to it. The school can benefit hugely from this income and use it to provide new equipment or maybe more support staff.

- ◆ Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).
- ◆ Income Support (IS).
- ◆ Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA).
- ◆ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA).
- ◆ The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
- ◆ Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- ◆ Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190).
- ◆ Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment you get for a further 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in state funded schools in England are eligible for a free school dinner, every day under the Government scheme, called a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM).

Please if you are eligible, still claim for the Pupil Premium/Free School Meal funding.

To apply <https://www.devon.gov.uk/supportforschools/services-and-contacts/free-school-meals> through the [Citizen Portal](#). This is the quickest and easiest way to apply and will result in you getting an instant decision.

In addition, we also receive funding of £300.00 per child for those children whose parents are in the services and £2300.00 for children who are adopted, have a special guardianship order, a child arrangement order or a residence order. If this applies to you and you would like the school to claim, please contact the school office.


### Message from Pilton Community College


